Paul also sits on the board of OpenToken, Blockfolio, and BitOasis, is a mentor at The House Fund, Boost VC, and Alchemist, and is an advisor to Orchid, Origin, and Icon. Prior to joining Pantera, Paul worked at Strive Capital as an associate focusing on investments in the mobile space, including an early stage investment in App Annie. Previously, Paul was at Hatch Consulting and LECG and performed partnerships and growth for Urban Spoils, an early stage startup in the daily deal space. Paul graduated from the University of California, Berkeley.

He is also the co-founder of Blockchain Wire and was the head of international strategy and innovation at OKEx. Enzo holds an MBA from Cornell University Johnson School.

## Simon Lapscher

Simon is the Co-Founder of Liquidity, a cross-blockchain unintermediated exchange network and wallet project. Hailing from Venezuela, Simon had the experience of living under a currency-controlled dictatorship and hence came to understand the need for censorship-resistant protocols. He holds a degree in engineering from Georgia Tech. He got into Bitcoin in 2013, which led him to create Deloitte's Blockchain Practice in 2014 which he co-ran until joining ConsenSys in 2017.
